FORMAT: Initial Fontes groups of 4, followed by pairing top contenders against each other, with all

others paired Swiss, with minimal repeats in both cases. Gibson rule applies.

AM announcements begin at 8:55 a.m., followed by final 3 rounds.

Prize ceremony begins at 1:30 p.m.
