## A Brand New Year!

We have made it through our first full year! I am really pleased with how the organization has transitioned from the many years of superb organization by the NSA and am truly amazed by the number of members and tournaments on the schedule.

As mentioned in previous bulletins and articles, there had been a pretty steady membership base of about 10-11,000 people with 2,000 members in any given year. We expected an attrition of 10% and had a goal of 1,800 members for 2010. We almost doubled that number as NASPA had 3,442 dues paying members through 2010.


Since NASPA is a brand new entity, I was concerned with renewals. The Membership Committee, chaired by Mad Palazzo, came up with some great incentives to renew that were outlined at the National SCRABBLE Championship by committee member John Robertson.

We expected about 1,200 renewals by January as people did not need to sign up until they played their first event of the year. And, again, we were looking conservatively at renewals due to so many new people signing on last year as well as the continuing economic difficulties the world faces. We have already exceeded our first year's plan for total membership and, as of this writing, have already sold 2,000 years of membership. That should keep us in business for a while, don't you think?

Please accept a huge "thank you" from all of us at NASPA, particularly those who demonstrated extreme confidence in the future of the organization by purchasing the maximum available 5 year renewals.

I believe we were able to capitalize on an increased interest in SCRABBLE that developed online at various sites. In years past at the NSA, the organization would lose and gain 450 players each year resulting in pretty constant numbers. This group would be comprised of those leaving for a variety of reasons and of those who came aboard, 350 of which were returning members and about 100 new members. While the NSA had no advertising budget provided to them by Hasbro other than what Hasbro did on their own, NASPA is easing into advertising our product. Our Facebook advertising resulted in over 500 new members this past year. Pretty interesting and amazing stuff. We hope that the retention rate is higher than normal.

Stefan Fatsis' book, "Word Freak: Heartbreak, Triumph, Genius, and Obsession in the

World of Competitive SCRABBLE Players," which resulted in many new faces including the author himself, is due for a ten-year reprint complete with an updated Afterword. We hope this will create another uptick in membership. Hasbro and the NSA will be running another School SCRABBLE Championship this April in Orlando, FL and NASPA will be there recruiting members of the future. Hasbro has added an insert to the million boards they sell a year that has NASPA's logo and website.

As of January 18, 2011, there are 166 tournaments on the calendar for this year with more being added weekly. I intend to really hit the road again this year to try to meet and speak to as many of our members as possible. Next up for me is the big, four-day Eastern Championship in Charlotte, North Carolina this President's Day weekend, February 18-21. Ryan Fischer and John Luebkemann are superlative hosts. Come check it out!

# **Canadian Committee Elections**

NASPA's Canadian Committee (CC) was established to deal with issues specifically affecting Canadian SCRABBLE players. For example, the CC determines the qualification criteria process for the Canadian National SCRABBLE Championship and international competitions, such as the Causeway Challenge and the World SCRABBLÉ Championship.

The CC consists of six members representing three geographical areas: western Canada, Ontario, and the Quebec/Atlantic region. There must be at least one member from each region but no more than three per region. Members from the territories and abroad are welcome, and would sit as members at large.

Like other NASPA committees, the CC was originally made up of appointed volunteers. However, the CC quickly decided to make itself a democratically elected body. All CC members serve staggered three-year terms, with two members' terms expiring on December 31 each year. At the 2009 NSC

from CANADIAN COMMITTEE, p. 1 in Dayton, OH, a lottery was held to determine whose terms would expire when. Annual elections would start beginning in November of 2009. No general election was held in 2009 because only two candidates, Tony Leah and Randall Thomas, ran for office. Thus they were elected by acclamation.

In 2010 three candidates ran for two positions necessitating a general election. The top two vote-getters would be elected for a term starting on January 1, 2011 and ending on December 31, 2013. All Canadian NASPA members in good standing were eligible to vote for up to two candidates. The NASPA website provided an opportunity for online voting. Mailed-in ballots were also accepted by Randall Thomas, who served as returning officer. Seventy Canadians exercised their right to vote. John Robertson (64 votes) and Jeff Parsons (27 votes) were both re-elected to the CC. Carl Madden (25 votes) finished a very close third.

Another election will be held in November 2011. The terms of David Boys and Siri Tillekeratne both expire at the end of 2011. They are eligible to run for reelection if they so choose. Any Canadian NASPA member may run in the election. To get your name on the ballot, please contact the CC during the official nominating period which runs from September 1 to October 15. The election period runs throughout November.

CC members don't have to be expert SCRABBLE players. They just need to be interested in promoting SCRABBLE and willing to share their ideas about issues that affect Canadians. Please read the CC's Wikipage on the NASPA website for further details.


